We are praying for, hoping and planning a faith exploration and confirmation group for youth to be held in mid-April here at SAUC.

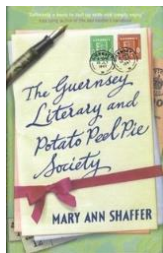
This journey is a wonderful chance to ask questions, learn, think, love and share.
