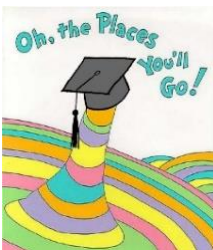

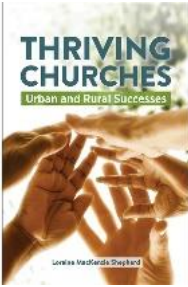

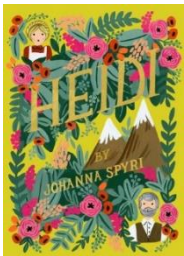
NEW DATES!!
